Dear parent,

Milestones are important and significant in one's journey. These milestones signify a level of achievement and serve as an impetus to move further on, in our journeys.

And that is what happened during our Navarathri break. Akshar Arbol International School completed 9 years of existence and stepped into the 10th year. So officially, we rang in the 10th year on Vijayadasami this year. Many of our staff and students were excited by this news. And with these well-developed sensibilities, each one would actualise his/her potential as they step into their world. At that time, it was sheer blind faith and trust in our undiluted and unadulterated dream that made us plunge into this ocean.

The tagline 'nurturing young minds' was important and came from our own belief in education and learning. As the idea of AAIS began to take shape, one of our Board members asked, "what do you envision? Give us a metaphor." 
