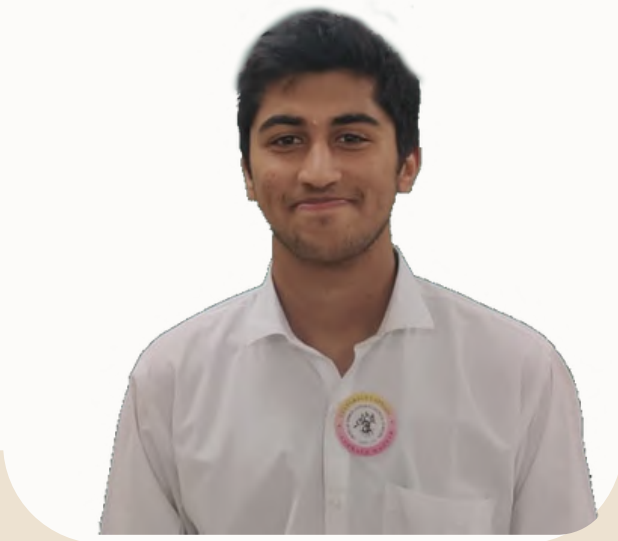


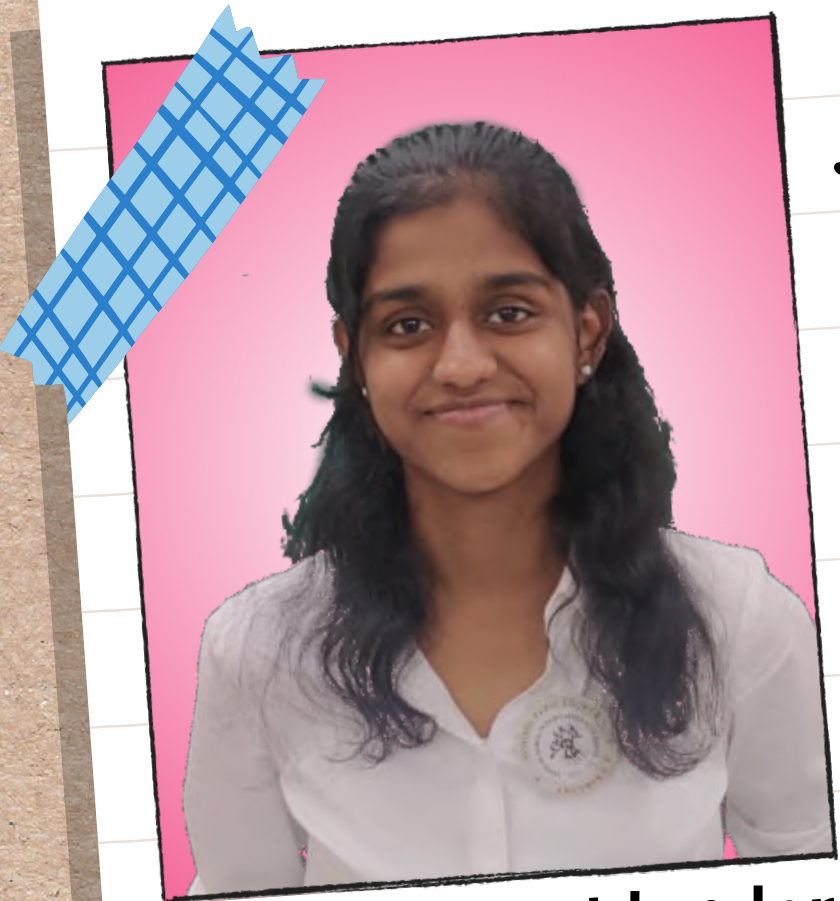
MEET THE STUDENT COUNCIL

Anushika, 912

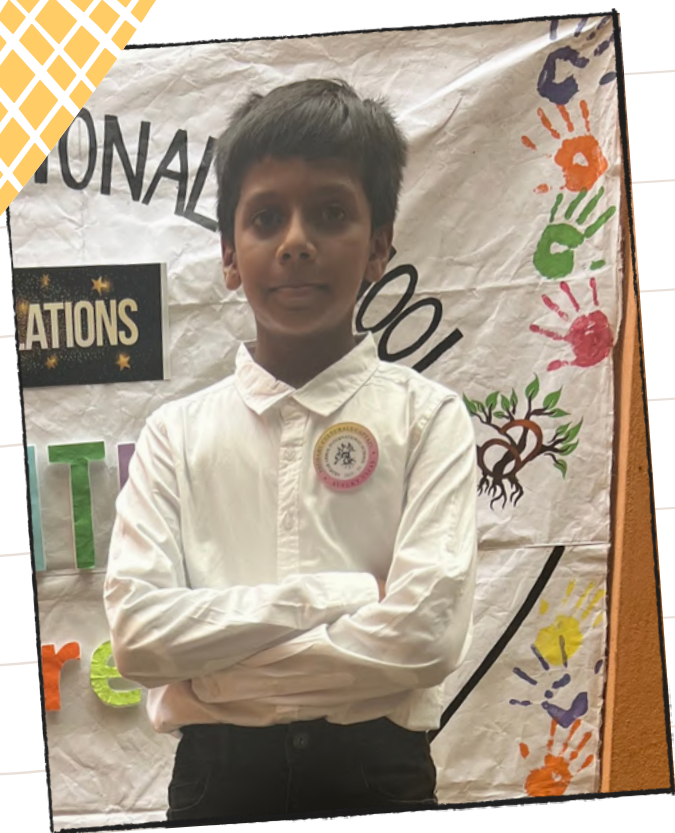

Aryukth Vijay, 95

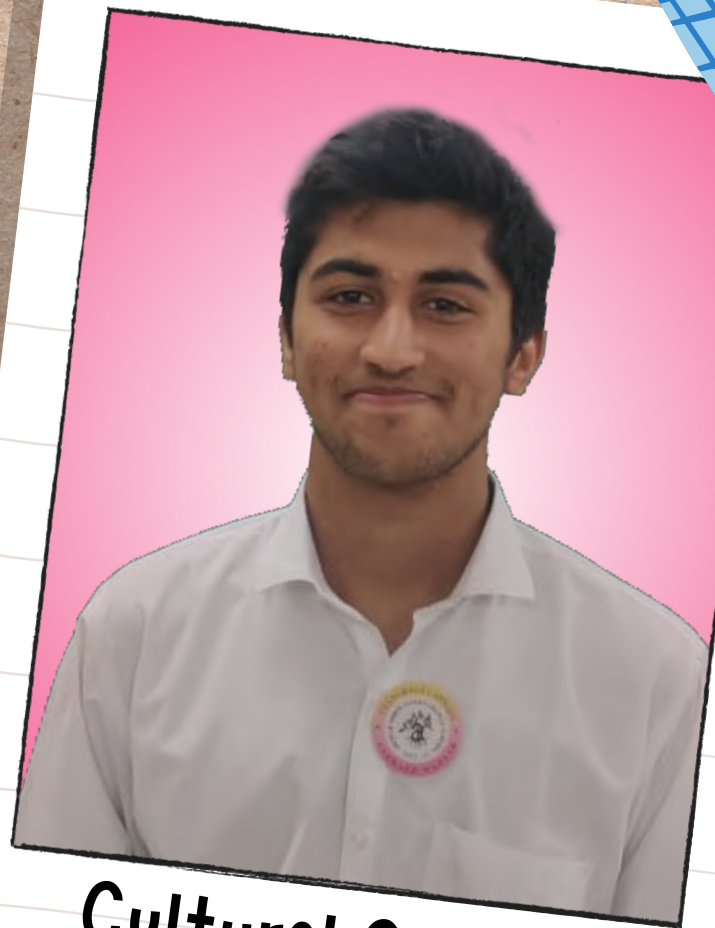

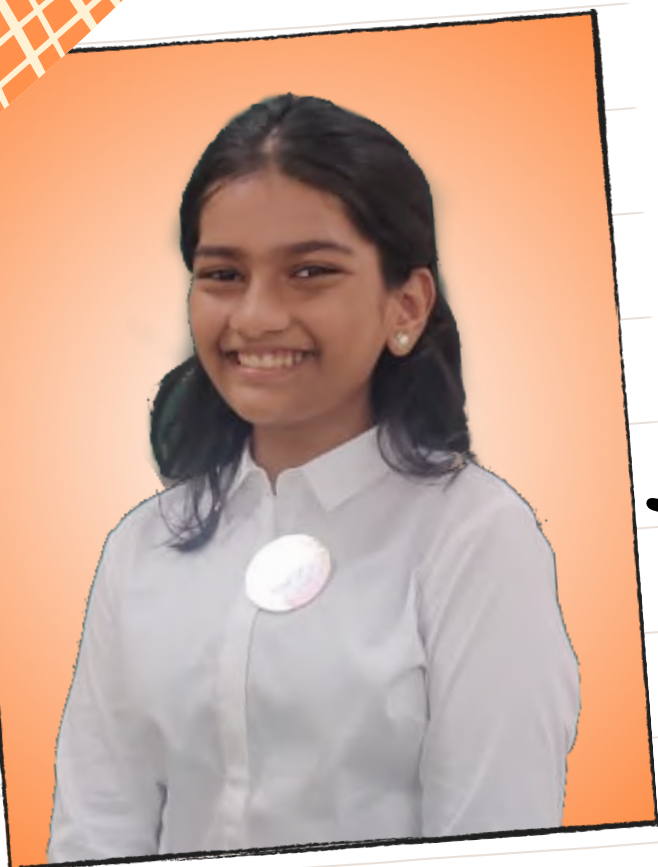


Cultural Captain
